The Women's Funding Network 25th Anniversary Conference was held on April 30 - May 2 in Atlanta. The Conference provided a unique venue for attendees to share innovative strategies for raising and managing the resources that achieve lasting social return. ## WOMEN MOVING MILLIONS

*Women Moving Millions* is an initiative aimed at improving the lives of women and girls around the world. The group's fundraising goal: encourage 90 women to commit at least \$1 million each to address the world's biggest issues. This historic campaign was launched by Swanee and Helen LaKelly Hunt in partnership with the **Women's Funding Network**. The campaign has garnered astounding results – to date \$176 million has been raised, far exceeding the original campaign goal of \$150 million.
